This unique class balances the high energy & discipline of Kung Fu to build fitness and learn martial art techniques with the calming of Tai chi to focus energy and build confidence & concentration. 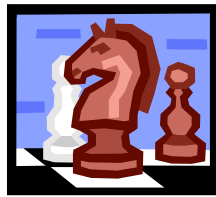
## **JUNIOR DANCE CLUB**

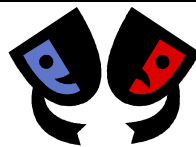
## **JUNIOR ART CLUB**

## **RULES FOR CLUBS: PLEASE READ CAREFULLY**

- The club leaders expect a high standard of behaviour from **all** children. Children will have their membership withdrawn if they are unhelpful, argumentative, inattentive or spoil the club in any way for other children or adults taking part. The Leader's decision is final and no refund will be offered. Subsequent places at clubs may also be withheld as a result of poor behaviour.
- Appropriate PE kit, including footwear, **must** be worn for relevant clubs. Please ensure that the kit is both suitable for the activity and the time of year. *Children without appropriate kit will **not** be allowed to join in.*
- The activities have been selected to enhance the children's education in specific areas. Children should only join if they are genuinely interested in the activity. With the exception of the Fun Time Club, school clubs are **not** child-minding facilities.
- Children **must** be collected promptly at the end of clubs, repeated lateness of collection will result in membership being withdrawn.
- Fees are payable in advance and should be returned to the school office with the acceptance slip. Fees are non-refundable once a place has been booked.
- Children will be accepted into clubs on a first come, first served basis. Slips and payments should be returned to the office.
- Children not attending clubs (i.e. siblings or friends) may not be left unattended to be spectators at other clubs.
- Children who are in school, but unable to attend an after school club are asked to inform the club leader beforehand that they will be absent.

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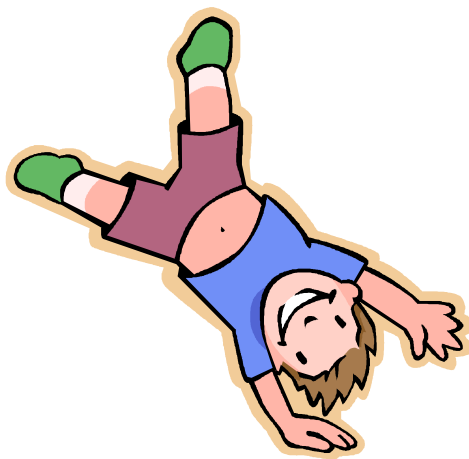
