




Click 'Next'

Alternatively, you can Google search 'Google Classroom' and log in through their home page.






You will come to a screen that looks like this. Click on your class name to enter the classroom.

If this screen pops up, click 'I'm a student'.






Then click 'Join'.

(This may have already been done if your child has had a lesson on Google Classroom)




This is the Google Classroom home screen where there will be posts from the teacher and an area where the children can make comments, interact and see what work has been set.


