



## Year 2 Phonics Screening Check 2020-2021

The cancellation of the Phonics Screening Check in June 2020 meant that our current Year 2 cohort for 2020/21 did not take the check in Year 1. For the 2020/21 academic year only, it was statutory for schools to administer a past version of the Phonics Screening Check to Year 2 pupils during the second half of the 2020 Autumn Term. Year 2 pupils who met the expected standard in phonics in the Autumn check will not be required to complete any further statutory assessments in phonics. Year 2 pupils who did not meet the expected standard in the Autumn check will be expected to take the statutory check in June 2021.

We are incredibly proud of our Autumn Term Phonics Screening Check Results (taken at the end of November 2020) and we look forward to the final percentage in the Summer Term. The average pass rate for the Local Authority in 2019 was 85%.

*\*The pass mark was 32 out of 40.*
