Charging Policy: 2012

Grove Park Primary School does not charge for any activities undertaken in school time, with the exception of optional individual or group music tuition and board and lodgings for children attending residential trips.

We do not charge for items required for day-to-day lessons which form part of the national curriculum, such as pencils, pens or paper. We may, however, charge for lost or damaged library books or reading books which are damaged or lost due to neglect.

We do, however, invite parents to make voluntary contributions towards items that incur a cost to the school such as educational trips, workshops, travel expenses and swimming lessons. These contributions are voluntary, although if we do not receive sufficient funds to cover the cost of an event, it may be necessary to cancel it.

Parents are invited to speak, in confidence, to the Headteacher and request a reduced rate for items such as optional after school activities. This assistance is up to the discretion of the club provider and the school and will be judged on an individual basis.
